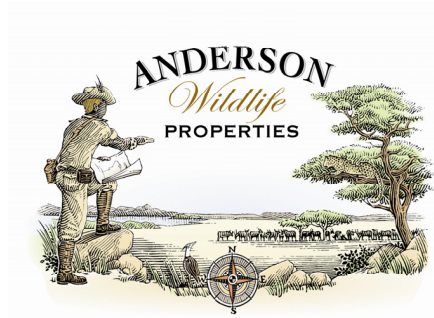
Conservation and Communities
